

33 Years (1985-2018) of Glorious Service to the Nation

In 1985 India's "Own Helicopter Company" was envisioned by the nation's think tank and, subsequently, realized with the incorporation of "Helicopter Corporation of India Ltd." (HCIL sa PHL was known then). The Inauguration function was carried out by then Prime Minister Shri. Rajeev Gandhi

In 2010, Gujarat State Petroleum Corporation Ltd. one of the leading oil and gas exploration, development and production companies in India. Pawan Hans provided on Dauphin N3 for its offshore requirements.

In 2011, Pawan Hans provided Mi-172 for carriage of VIP and other passengers in state. Govt. of Himachal Pradesh.

The commercial operation of Pawan Hans for ONGC was commercial on 6th October 1986 with two helicopter flying from Juhu Airodrom, Mumbai to offshore rigs of Mumbai high.

In 2009, the First Helicopter Commenced flying at Ranchi. Pawan Hans took operations & maintenance of the Advanced Light Helicopter (ALH) of Border Security Force.

In 2013, Govt. of West Bengal in association with PHL has launched regular helicopter services from Kolkata connecting various strategic towns and spiritual destinations, including Gangasagar, Durgapur, Malda, Balurghat and Shantimiketan.



In 1987, Pawan Hans started the specialised services of carry out pipeline inspection and surveillance for Oil India Limited. Initially the R-44 helicopter used and there after 350 D-3 has been employed, the utilization of these Helicopters for the task is most efficient and fast.

In 2008, Pawan Hans Ltd. has undertaken the specialized task of Power Line Maintenance by Bell 206 Helicopter. This was done without shutting down the power lines.

In 2015, Pawan Hans Limited has provided bell 206 Helicopter to AP Tourism development corporation for commercial 'joy ride' during the nine-day Tirumala Brahmotsavams, there by initiating Heli Tourism Tirupati. this enabled tourists to have an aerial view of the temple city, Chandragiri fort and the Srinivasa Mangapuram Temple from the altitude of 500 feet within 8 to 10 minutes.

In 1990, for Aerial Inspection & Pipeline Surveillance, Bell 407/AS 350 B3 was provided to GAIL India Limited for its wide network of pipeline in the country.

In 2003, Pawan Hans has been Providing 4 dauphin N helicopters to the Andaman & Nicobar islands. The Helicopters Provide regular inter island services for passengers and Govt. officials. The Services of Pawan Hans are a great tourist attraction to places like havelock and Niel Islands.

From 1/12/2007 to 31/1/2010 Pawan Hans provided had a Dauphin helicopter on wet lease to the Govt. of Nagaland. On 1st June 2015 Dauphin N Helicopter has been provided to the state Govt. for operation regular passenger flights connecting various sectors within the state.



On 25th September, 2000, Pawan Hans provided Bell and Dauphin N Helicopter on wet lease to the Govt. of Tripura for regular passenger services connecting Agartala, Dharmanagar, Kailashaar etc. and for other purposes within the state.

Antarctica Expedition Pawan Hans had provided crucial Helicopter support for XVIIIth (Dec-98 to Mar-99) & XIXth (Dec-99 to march, 2000) Indian Scientific Expedition to Antarctica by way of ferrying men, material and equipments. It was the first time that an Indian Civil Helicopter company was awarded the contract against international tender.

In 2006, Pawan Hans took on the operations and maintenance of the Bihar State owned SA 365N Dauphin N helicopters. The Helicopter was used in carriage of VIPs and other Passengers while it operated from Patna airport.

In 1999, Pawan Hans provided a Dauphin Helicopter on wet lease to the Govt. of Meghalaya w.e.f. 15 February. The state Govt. had been operation daily passenger flights on Guwahati-Shillong-Tura sector and other flights within the state.

In 1998, Govt. of Sikkim, Pawan Hans has provided a 5 Seater Bell helicopter on wet lease to the Govt. of Sikkim since 31 october. The State Govt. has been operating daily passenger, tourist, flights on Gangtok-Bagdogra-Gangtok sector (6 days in a week) and other flights too.

In 2003, Pawan Hans has deployed helicopters bell 407/AS365N for Major Pilgrimage sites in India Pawan Hans Services Included Helicopter Travel to the Kedarnath Ji & Amarnath Ji.



Pawan Hans Pays Dividend to GoI

Pawan Hans achieved yet another record by registering a remarkable Profit After Tax (PAT) of Rs. 242.78 crores during 2016-17 and paid dividend of Rs.36.99 crores to GOI and ONGC for the financial year 2016-17 on 23rd March, 2018 at Ministry of Civil Aviation, Rajiv Gandhi Bhawan, New Delhi.

The cheque of Rs.18.86 crores for the financial year 2016-17 was presented to the Hon'ble Minister of Civil Aviation Shri Suresh Prabhu by Dr. B.P Sharma, CMD, Pawan Hans in the presence of Hon'ble Minister of State for Civil Aviation Shri Jayant Sinha, Secretary, Civil Aviation, Shri R.N. Choubey and other senior officials of Ministry and Pawan Hans.

Pawan Hans has also outlined its Business Road Map-2025 for its overall business expansion in Operational Services (Helicopters, Seaplanes and Small Fixed Wing Aircrafts), Training & Skill Development, Business Development & Projects (MRO, Heliports/ Helipads) and Consultancy Services & Foreign Projects and RCS-UDAN-II and also to be 100 helicopters company by 2025.

Under RCS-UDAN-II scheme of GoI, PHL won 11 Helicopter routes to connect various small towns in Uttarakhand, Himachal, Manipur and Assam etc. PHL has also launched its regular helicopter services for Daman –Diu-Daman sectors in association with Daman & Diu Administration on 24th Feb 2018.

The new website has been designed to provide the ultimate user-friendly experience with improved navigation and functionality throughout for customers delight. E-Portal for online charter and e-ticket booking also a part of this website for passenger under ease of booking tickets cashlessly to promote digital India initiative of GoI.

WINGS OF CONNECTIVITY

The Government has awarded 56 airports under the Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) - UDAN - in the last two years, of which 18 airports have been operationalised, with two airports being made functional under the scheme every month.

This was revealed by Civil Aviation Secretary M Choudary at 'WINGS OF CONNECTIVITY' organised jointly by FICCI, Ministry of Civil Aviation and Airport Authority of India. The theme of the four-day event this year is 'India's Global Aviation Hub'.

Choudary said the Government was committed to connecting the cities and towns to increase regional connectivity in the country. He added that all prices needed to remain soft, below \$80 a barrel, for the sector to grow at a CAGR of 15% for the next 20 years.

Highlighting a major concern of the sector, he said IAT (an Aviation Tariff) was among the highest in the world. To address the issue, Choudary suggested the inclusion of AIP in the GST framework of the states bringing down IAT to 5%.

Concluding with WINGS India 2018, FICCI launched its maiden edition of 'WINGS' the DAA AWARDS for Excellence in the aviation sector. The awards were conferred upon Aviation-related Companies/Institutions/Organisations in 54 categories at the event.

The two-day event is witnessing the presence of 125 exhibitors and 35 CEOs. WINGS INDIA 2018 is also seeing representation from 10 countries, namely USA, Japan, UK, Russia, Singapore, France, Germany, Malaysia, Hong Kong, Italy and Iran.

Besides, 15 awards by ATR, Honda, Pratt, Gulfstream, Boeing, Embraer, Dassault, Airbus, One A2, Airtec, Zivko Air, Air India, HAL and others are on show at the static display.


