
## पवन हंस

## SH. E.K. BHARAT BHUSHAN, DG, DGCA AT PAWAN HANS JUHU COMPLEX, MUMBAI





The Gliding Centre at Hadapsar Pune is under the administrative control of Director General of Civil Aviation (DGCA). DGCA have assigned the task of "**Development of Helicopter Training Institute & Heliport at Gliding Centre at Hadapsar, Pune**" to PHHL.

NBCC shall provide Project Management Consultancy support in Planning, Designing and Construction of proposed Helicopter Training Institute &



Heliport at Gliding Centre at Hadapsar, Pune" to PHHL. This agreement will help in making Hadapsar Gliding Centre, Pune to become a hub as a Helicopter Training Institute for Pilots and Technical Personnel as well a fully developed heliport, in due course time, which can be used by the business community, disaster management agencies, medical evacuations and police enforcement agencies.

It is pertinent to mention that with all out efforts, PHHL has managed to associate with such kind of International Event which is also the show case for India, where PHHL also got an opportunity for long term association with such International Clients.

Accordingly, PHHL had earmarked 2 Nos. helicopter to

support the above event - 1 twin engine Dauphin N and one single engine AS 350 B3 helicopter for operations during the above period. PHHL was also prepared to provide its services for any kind of Disaster and to utilize the Akshardham Helipad in case of any Disaster.

PHHL is proud to mention that on 30th October, 2011, Mr. Eric Besson, French Minister for industry, Energy and the Digital Economy along with its delegation were in PHHL Daulphin Helicopter from Buddha International Circuit, Greater Noida to IGI, Airport.

This is the second time after CWG 2010 Games that PHHL has been associated to provide its services in suh an international event - which is a Show Case for India.

### ORRISA - FLOOD RELIEF OPERATIONS

It is a matter of great pride that PHHL have been a part of a major flood relief operation carried out in the State of Orissa. It was a more devastating flood in Orissa as compared to past floods in the State and affected more than 14 lakh people in 19 districts of Orissa.

Pawan Hans has provided one 26 seater Mi-172 helicopter to Govt. of Orissa on long term lease basis for movement of mass and materials.

Govt. of Orissa have rightly involved Pawan Hans Helicopter (Mi-172) for Flood relief Operations. The Helicopter was

used for aerial survey of flood affected areas by Ho'ble Chief Minister Shri. Naveen Patnaik and for air-dropping of food items. State Govt. have pressed total 4 Helicopters in flood relief operation, 1 from Air Force (Mi-17), 2 from Navy (Sea King) and 1 Helicopter from Pawan Hans Helicopters Ltd (Mi-172).

During Flood Operations at Orissa, PHHL carried 20.5 ton of load and made 9 sorties for flood operations during September 11 to September 15, 2011 with total flying hours of 17 hrs plus PHHL Helicopter was used for aerial survey at Sambalpur, Hirakund and Bargarh and air-dropping of

food packets/relief material at Kendrapara Dist., Jagatsinghpur and Puri.

PHHL team worked day and night to serve for this national level calamity and made this operation successful. PHHL team at Bhubaneshwar, who carried out this task includes – Capt. P.P Singh, Capt. Ashish Vohra, Shri V.C Katoch (AME), Shri J.K Singh (Flight Engineer), Shri Yevraj Thapa (Cabin attendant), Shri S.K Mishra (Technician), Shri S.M Singh (Technician) and other Ground Staff stationed at Bhubaneshwar.





## Pawanhans dedicated 3 choppers for Earthquake relief / rescue operations in Sikkim

Pawan Hans has continued its efforts from 19th September, 2011 onwards for providing helicopter support services to the State Govt. of Sikkim to carry out relief/rescue operations after the massive earthquake which had affected the people in mass in Sikkim. At present 3 Nos. of helicopters are operating to carry out the above tasks.

PHHL has rescued approx. 500 + people from various quake affected areas to the nearby base stations/camps including dead bodies/major injured people/ pregnant women/ kids. The helicopters are also being utilized for transporting the relief material in far flung areas of North Sikkim, worst affected by Earthquake. PHHL team is

actively undertaking the relief task in close coordination with STDC. The backup team & Ground staffs are also making all out efforts to keep Helicopter serviceable for providing uninterrupted support to the State. Day & Night Maintenance task being carried out by PHHL team to keep the helicopters always serviceable"
