



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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING- 2014-15 BETWEEN PAWAN HANS LIMITED AND MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION

PART- I. VISION, MISSION AND OBJECTIVES OF PAWAN HANS LIMITED

- a) <u>VISION</u>
 "Enable the people to have access to safe, secure, sustainable, affordable world class niche aviation services."
- b) MISSION

 To become a market leader in Helicopters and Sea Plane services, to provide regional connectivity through Small Fixed Wing Aircrafts operations and provide repair/overhaul services at par with international standards.
- c) OBJECTIVES:
 - To initiate fleet replacement / enhancement plan.
 - > To achieve optimum utilization of the fleet.
 - To ensure continuous improvement in safety both in the air and on the ground comparable to the best in the aviation industry.
 - > To diversify into repair/overhaul facilities / services.
 - To provide helicopter training, safety service and create infrastructure namely Heliports/Helipads.
 - > Capital restructuring to facilitate fleet enhancement plan.
 - To improve Internal Management Practices and build capacity within the Organization.

PART-II. AUTONOMY AND DELEGATION OF FINANCIAL POWERS

To exercise powers as laid down by DPE for MOU signing Companies.

In fulfillment of its obligation under the MOU, Pawan Hans Ltd. undertakes to achieve the Performance Targets for 2014-2015 as per Annexure-I.

PART-IV. COMMITMENTS / ASSISTANCE FROM THE GOVERNMENT

- a) To assist Pawan Hans in issues concerning Central / State Government agencies and PSUs for helicopter, seaplane and small fixed wing services.
- b) To facilitate early settlement of Government of India's claim with regard to purchase of Westland helicopters and capital restructuring of the Company.
- c) To help in timely recovery of dues from North Eastern States and other States / customers.
- d) To help Pawan Hans in getting the restriction of 5 years old aircraft recently introduced by ONGC removed or relaxed to 10 years.
